

| 4. | Public Representations | Question raised regarding the Telephone Box; Council confirmed that when funds are available a defibrillator will be installed. COH will have it cleaned in due course when work commitments allow. Residents also queried the flyposting on the phone box. Council is unable to do anything about this unless they are aware of the companies responsible. Residents are welcome to take the posters down. Problem overhanging trees/hedges are still causing an issue, resident has logged the matter with MK Council. Council will again approach the property owners concerned. Tamlin Barton introduced himself as our Development management planning buddy; and will be available to the Parish Council to answer any general planning queries they may have. |
| 5. | Ward Councillors' Update | HIF Bid - The Treasury has announced successful HIF bids, Milton Keynes was not named as one of those successful bids, were expecting to hear in the Autumn. Should a general election be called there will be no further announcements. MK East SPD – Milton Keynes Council consultation events have been announced to be held in Newport Pagnell, Willen and Moulsoe. Residents to be urged to attend. If the HIF bid is not successful, the SPD will stop, the situation will be back to where it was before and until the next phase of Plan:MK nothing will happen. Ward Tour – Ward Councillors recently completed a Ward tour with Director of Environmental and Property and his team, although they didn't get to Moulsoe, many of our ongoing issues are mirrored in other parts of the Ward. |

| 6.1 | MK East (SPD) Consultation | Parish Council to meet on 15 October 8 pm to draft a response to the SPD Consultation and make it available to residents via the village website. |
| 6.2 | MK Forum Meeting | MK Forum have now announced a public meeting on 3 October at Margaret Powell House to discuss the SPD consultation. |
| 6.3 | Millennium Hall Parking | The proposed response to issue of the overflow parking on the playing field was discussed. The Parish Council want to make it clear that they are not intending to stop the MCA from hiring the hall out. Council are supportive of all the MCA want to do for the hall, but things must be looked at and reviewed as time moves on and usage changes. Question raised that the overflow parking has worked up to now and as a result of comments the MCA have changed how the parking is being supervised. No issues have been reported since these changes have been implemented. Discussion continued regarding insurance, lease conditions, use and condition of the playing field. All Councillors voted by a show of hands to send their response to the MCA voted 4:1 Councillors RESOLVED send the response. |
| 6.4 | Traffic & Roads | Road Safety Initiative - Funding for Speed Watch/Sentintel - Ward councillors suggested approaching the community infrastructure fund, also Central Bedfordshire for section 106 money. Moulsoe S106 money has been confirmed by MKC as spent on the road marking scheme 4 years ago therefore funding to purchase our own equipment will |

| | | <p>be needed. SW has put a case to TVP Local Area Commander via Lucy Boddington and they were very supportive in our need for funding. TVP are planning to invest in their own Speed Watch equipment and it maybe we would be able to use this in addition to the MKC Speed Watch kit.</p> <p>ANPR - Steve has been talking to TVP and Lucy Boddington. TVP will purchase the cameras and Moulsoe, Lavendon and North Crawley will share the cost of installing the posts. A site survey has been done and TVP are ready to place the posts. Cameras will still be moved as when police intel require them, but likely they stay within the three parishes. The cost to each parish will be £1077.</p> <p>Council voted on the funding of ANPR and RESOLVED unanimously to go ahead.</p> <p>A509 junction drainage – Clerk has been in contact with Clerk of Works and this is on the list to do, but with the M1 works they are unable to start on this. M1 works will be there for the foreseeable future, so what is the issue that it can't be fixed. We have been waiting for 2 years and it does cause concerns with traffic using other side of the carriageway.</p> <p>Ward Councillors suggested email Davina and copy in WC, to highlight that it needs to be dealt with.</p> <p>VASS – not working log via MKC Report It</p> <p>SID Data – 1/3 of all vehicles coming through the village are exceeding 35 mph. Top speed logged was 78 mph.</p> |
| 6.5 | Village Clean Up | <p>Notice boards still need attention JH will paint them.</p> <p>Overhanging hedges - discussion as to whether parish council could have a working party to clear areas that are a problem. Council aware that these hedges/trees are on private property, but they are possibly causing visibility problems from the road for HGV/buses etc.</p> |
| 6.6 | Parish Councillor Updates | <p>Rural Crime - There have been reports of hare coursing on our local farms and sheep rustling/slaughter in Northamptonshire. Residents to be vigilant of unusual activity/vehicles in fields and report to 101 if concerned. 101 service is slowly improving there's also an online option which might be quicker when reporting incidents. NR is part of a Farming WhatsApp group and can alert neighbouring farms.</p> <p>Newport police station has been closed but our policing team is operating from Wolverton.</p> <p>Rural Crime Week 7 – 11 October</p> <p>Wildlife Crime Officer – Dan Smith is being trained for this role</p> |
